

ADMISSIONS

Transfer at Age 11

Application should be made on the Barnet Application form and submitted to the LEA which allocates places for all community schools in Barnet. This school is always over-subscribed. The LEA applies the admission criteria below.

Full details of the admissions process can be found in the booklet 'A Guide to Secondary Education in Barnet 2007' which is issued to parents of all pupils due to transfer to Year 7.

Criteria

Where the school is over-subscribed, places will be allocated in the following order:

- 1) Boys who have a statement of special educational need that specifically names this school.
- 2) Boys applying who are 'looked after' by the London Borough of Barnet under the provision of the Children's Act 1989.
- 3) Boys who, when places are allocated, have a brother living at the same address in Years 7-11 of the school, (or who is in Years 12-13 if they previously attended in Years 7-11 for at least one year). Brothers would include half, step, adoptive and foster brothers provided they also live at the same address as the applicant.
- 4) Remaining places are offered on a geographical basis measuring distance in a straight line from the school.

Later or Mid-Year Admissions

Pupils who are applying after the beginning of the academic year or who require a place in a year group other than Year 7 should apply directly to Christ's College Finchley. We will ask you to complete a form and the pupil's name will be placed on our waiting list. We will contact you when a place becomes available.
